NOTE:

Payment for any one package will be accepted in two installments, one-half on or before 1st April, and one-half on or before 1st July of the current year. Interest will not be charged until after 1st July.

Upon payment of the package the rental fees appropriate to the package will apply. These rates cannot be applied to flights retroactively.

To encourage earlier flying starts, particularly for students, all tow fees will be reduced by the amount shown for tows with a take-off time before 11:00.

INTRODUCTORY FLIGHT

- includes: day membership
glider rental
3,000 foot tow (2,000 foot tow under soaring conditions).
- Maximum flight duration of 30 minutes.
- The fee will be credited if the person taking the introductory flight joins the Club within 30 days of the flight. This applies to first-time members only.

'5-PACK' FLYING PACKAGE

- includes: five glider flying lessons
five 3,000 foot tows (2,000 foot tow under soaring conditions)
day membership
basic student kit

Each flight is limited to a maximum of 30 minutes. Flights exceeding 30 minutes are subject to overtime charge. Flight durations will vary due to weather conditions. No solo privileges. Packages are non-transferable and non-refundable, and are valid for only one person, until the end of the flying season of the year following the purchase. Limited to one non-repeating purchase.

VISITING GUEST MEMBERSHIP

- A flying package must also be purchased:
 - Package #1 for \$256.00 (any amount of flying in either AS-K13 or Blanik L-13)
 - Package #2 for \$405.00 (any amount of flying in any club glider)
- SAC fees are payable if the guest is not a member of SAC or an affiliated organization.
- Conditions:
 - Valid for 7 consecutive days starting the day of the first flight, once per season.
 - Prepayment required for membership and flying package (Note: no per minute charge).
 - Tows extra, charged at published club rates.
 - All club procedures/policies apply.
 - No refunds.

Notes:

1. If a duty person (field manager or assistant, instructor, tow pilot) fails to show up for their assigned duty, the person filling in for them is entitled to a 3,000ft tow at the expense of the person who failed to do their duty. This will be administered through the billing process.
2. The half season GGC membership fee applies to members who join GGC after the 31st of July, and who have not been a member in the preceding year. The half season SAC fee applies also after 31st July, but it applies only to persons who have never been a SAC member before.
3. Flying membership applies to flying members who make sole use of the facilities or with occasional guests.
Flying Family membership applies to flying members whose non-flying family are regular users of GGC facilities. Eligible family consists of spouse, child, parent or sibling. However, any person who wishes to fly as student or pilot must join GGC and SAC as student or flying member(s) as applicable.
4. A Junior Member shall be an individual who is under the age of twenty one (21) years as of the 31st day of December in the year of membership or, if over the age of 21, but under the age of twenty-five (25) on the 31st day of December in the year of membership shall be in full time attendance in an accredited post-secondary learning institution.
5. Air Cadet Membership applies to air cadets who are below the age of 19 as of 1st January and who are currently enrolled and serving as Royal Canadian Air Cadets.
6. Associate membership applies to persons who want to join GGC to participate in non-flying activities.
7. Day membership is mandatory for anyone who wants to take a passenger flight, except for family of GGC Flying Family members. Day membership allows full access to Club facilities on that day. Past GGC members of the previous year may complete up to five dual flights annually at club fees during one or several day memberships.
Day membership also applies to family or personal guests of GGC members who take passenger flights with qualified pilots, when the day membership fee and the flight fee are charged to that member's account.
8. All membership applications are subject to Board approval with the exception of day membership.
9. Charges for flights will be calculated using the package fee rate up to the applicable time limit, after which the overtime fee applies. However, for flights which have been authorized by the field manager to last beyond the applicable time limit, the daily maximum per flight will apply. This is the equivalent to a 3-hour flight. The field manager's authorization must be noted on the flight sheets. If an authorized flight results in a landing away from the take-off field then the time will be calculated from take-off to when the glider is returned and rigged, up to the 3 hours daily max.

Overtime fees apply to all flying packages.

Instructional flights are limited to 30 minutes, after which the overtime fee is applied. That fee is levied against the instructor.

All flights have a ten-minute minimum charge.

10. Interest charges at a monthly percentage rate of 2% will be applied to balances that are outstanding for more than 30 days.

Members will be charged a fee of \$35.00 for NSF cheques.

Requests for corrections to a member's account statement must be received by the 20th of each month to avoid interest charges.

Storage Fees

Summer storage is from April to October and Winter storage November to March.

The Board must approve the items to be stored at the Club who in turn have delegated this authority to the Property Manager.

eg: A Flying member with a campsite, 30ft trailer, ATV, canoe which are kept outside would pay $\$172+64+48=\284 for the summer season and $\$142+64+48=\254 for the Winter months for outside storage.
